



## Region 4 helping People with Disabilities

Innovative workstations, called the Accessibility Station (or X-Station), were designed by the Ruth Lilly Assistive Technology Center at Easter Seals Crossroads and allow accessibility for people with disabilities in several different ways. In 2007, Region 4 WorkOne West Central installed these workstations to offer this cutting-edge and comprehensive technology. They feature screen magnification and screen reading software; a video magnifier for printed materials; a document scanning and reading system; and a large-print keyboard are available for those with vision impairment.

For those with mobility impairment, these features are present: independent height adjustments for the keyboard, the mouse and the monitor; forearm supports; slip-on typing aids; an adjustable equipment-positioning system; a voice input system; a mouse/trackball text input system; a single-switch input system; a word prediction/abbreviation expansion program; a miniature keyboard; and alternate pointing devices. A voice input system; bimodal document-scanning and reading system; a literacy development system; and an Internet-access system are available for those with learning disabilities.
